NUBO wants to encourage future generations to be socially responsible, treat others with care and empathy and do our bit to support those less fortunate. This is why we are partnering with Sunrise Cambodia, a sustainable community development organisation with a focus on Cambodia's most vulnerable children and the communities in which they live.

Why?: Following the Japanese tradition of Senbazuru, NUBO pledges to fold 1000 origami cranes to send to Cambodia to grant the children of Sunrise hope for a lifetime of love and happiness.

From now till 24th of September, NUBO visitors are invited to create their own paper cranes which will be flown over to the children in Cambodia.

How?: Paper crane stations are now set up around NUBO centres, where educators will assist children to fold their crane and write a wish, positive word, or quote inside. Parents and carers are encouraged to make as many of these origami cranes to help us reach our goal!
